### Representative Matters

#### Coverage Litigation

- Lead coverage counsel for the largest workers' compensation insurer in the state, for cases pending throughout all districts of the Office of Workers' Compensation and Louisiana's state and federal courts, involving litigation and resolution of complex cases and claims and myriad issues including coverage disputes, duty to defend, coordination of coverage and benefits of multi-party and multi-state policies, Medicare Set Asides, and extra-contractual claims.
- Lead coverage counsel for insurer defending claims for alleged damages and penalties for allegedly breaching duty to defend policyholder, resulting in a Louisiana Supreme Court decision to reduce the damage award by over 85 percent.

#### Fiduciary Litigation

- Lead trial and appellate counsel to validate an irrevocable trust based on another state's constructive trust laws and the trust provisions, despite irregularities with the signature pages in the trust document itself and relying instead on the subsequent donations and transfers to the trustee to confirm the trust's validity.
- Lead trial counsel for executrix in claims over competing wills, including the resolution of the issues involving capacity of the decedent to execute an olographic will.

- Lead trial counsel in claims against estate of former curator of interdicted person to recover funds misappropriated by former curator.
- Lead trial counsel in defense of executor, leading to global resolution of all claims and partition of interests in multiple tracts in multiple parishes under terms of will.
- Lead trial counsel in succession proceeding on behalf of executor and original trustee, including obtaining a temporary restraining order against a putative successor trustee and resulting in the invalidation of the trust amendments to restore original trustee and rejection of efforts to remove executor.
